Deploying phpMyAdmin on IBM i using Zend Server



Another free, open source tool, phpMyAdmin helps you to manage MySQL 'over the web'. The tool 'supports a wide range of operations on MySQL and MariaDB' and will enable you to create, modify or delete databases, tables, rows and fields. You'll also be able to execute SQL statements and manage users and permissions.

- Log into the Zend Server console
- Navigate to the Guide Page
- Click on the phpMyAdmin icon
- The Application Package Download dialog will be displayed
 - Once the package has downloaded, Click Next
- The Readme dialog will be displayed
 - Click Next
- The Application Details dialog will be displayed
 - Enter an unique Display Name
 - Ensure the default server Virtual Host is specified, including the port number
 - Enter an unique Path
 - Click Next
- The End User License Agreement dialog will be displayed
 - Read the End User License Agreement, then check the checkbox
 - Click Next
- The Application Prerequisites dialog will be displayed
 - Check that all prerequisites are met
 - Click Next
- The User Parameters dialog will be displayed
 - Enter MySQL Server/Database Password
 - Click Next

- The Deployment Summary dialog will be displayed
 - Click Deploy
- The Applications List will be displayed
 - The deployment status of your application will be displayed
 - Once the application is deployed, click on the application to show the application Details
 - Click on the Base URL to launch the application
- Log in using User root and Password
